## Leaving money to the Woodcote Millennium Green Trust

There are two ways in which you can alter your Will in order to leave money to the Woodcote Millennium Green Trust, as described in the paragraphs below. The first, headed 'Pecuniary legacy', allows you to specify a particular sum of money. The second, headed 'Residuary gift', allows your Executors to pay the remainder of your estate to the Trust after any other bequests.

If you wish your legacy to be used for a particular purpose please make that clear. The Trustees will respect your wishes providing they would be acting in accordance with the Trust Deed in so doing.

## Pecuniary legacy

I give [ ] free of tax to the Woodcote Millennium Green Trust ("the Charity") RCN 1075872 for its general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of the person who appears to be the treasurer or other proper officer of the Charity shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors and I further direct that if at my death the Charity has ceased to exist or changed its name or amalgamated with another charity my executors shall pay this legacy to the charitable organisation which in their discretion they consider most nearly fulfils the objects of the Charity.

## Residuary gift

I give and bequeath [all]\* [state proportion]\* of the residue of my estate to the Woodcote Millennium Green Trust of 6 Sunnybank, Epsom, Surrey, KT18 7DX (registered charity number 1075872) ("the Charity") for its general <u>charitable</u> purposes and I direct that the receipt of <u>a person who appears to be</u> the Treasurer or other proper officer of <u>the Charity</u> shall be a good discharge to my Executors and I further direct that if at my death the Charity has ceased to exist or amalgamated with another charity or has changed its name my Executors shall pay this legacy to the charitable organisation which in their discretion most nearly fulfils the objects of the Charity.
